CHICAGO—Woman Made Gallery (WMG) presents *In Full View*, a juried group exhibition of work by 47 women and non-binary artists age 65 and older. Selected by Jerry Zbiral, the exhibition explores visibility and invisibility as they relate to identity, aging, memory, and the legacy of a fully lived life. The exhibition opens with a public reception on Saturday, October 10, from 4 to 7 p.m., and remains on view through November 7, 2026, at Woman Made Gallery, 1332 S. Halsted St., Chicago.

Working across a variety of mediums, including painting, sculpture, photography, fiber, and mixed media, the artists consider what it means to be seen, overlooked, remembered, or revealed, and how those experiences shape both life and art. 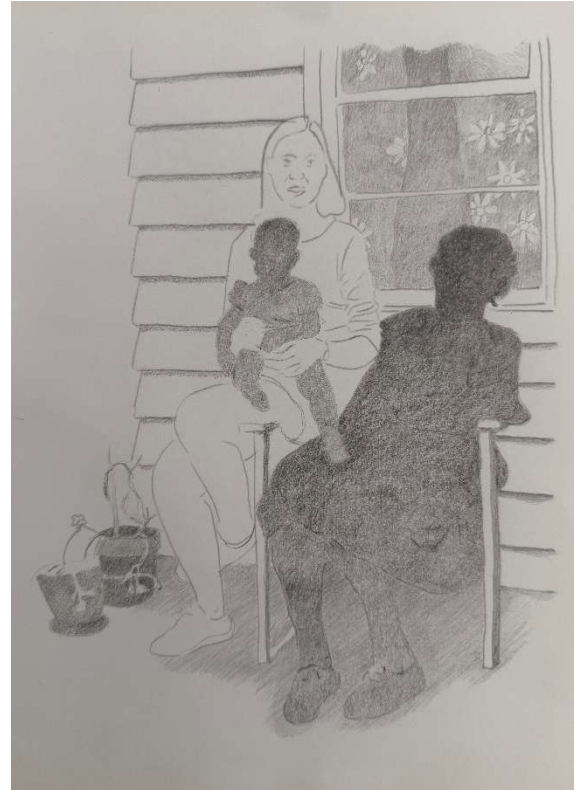

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About the Juror: Jerri Zbiral

Jerri Zbiral has devoted more than 40 years to the visual arts as a maker, teacher, writer, curator, dealer, and appraiser of film and photography. She has exhibited her work widely and published extensively on photography. With her husband, Alan Teller, she is a partner in *The Collected Image*, which appraises collections for private and public clients and provides contemporary and vintage photographs to major collectors and institutions. She produced and directed two award-winning films, *In the Shadow of Memory* and *Never Turning Back: The World of Peggy Lipschutz*. She and Alan completed a Fulbright trip to India for *Following the Box*, a project centered on anonymous photographs from 1945.
